



PACKING LIST AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR FRIDAY:

Bible
pen
clothes (church attire not required)
recreation clothes
socks
shoes
sleeping bag (or similar)
pillow
towel
washcloth
bar of soap
shampoo
deodorant
toothbrush
toothpaste
comb or brush
other personal items
prescribed medication
money for merchandise, snacks, etc.

DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS:

tube tops, tank tops, spaghetti straps, short shorts (if you cannot wear it to school, you cannot wear it to C-40)
electronic devices (iPods, laptops, hand-held games, etc.)
weapons
tobacco, alcohol, nor any other drug
valuables
